The juvenile referrals included here are only those filed with the clerks of court and serviced through the court's diversion program.

Table 14 on Page 38 represents the total number of protection order action for Domestic Relations and Stalking.

Table 15 on Page 39 identifies the trend of the number of abuse and neglect cases filed for the past five fiscal years. This trend has remained relatively steady for the past three fiscal years.

Chart 11. Civil Caseload Comparisons

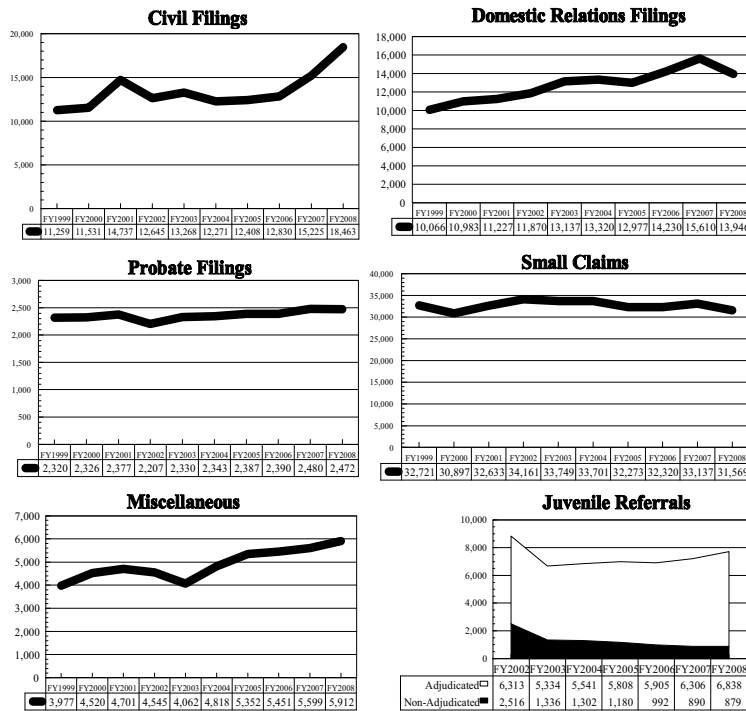
