Chart 11. Civil Caseload Comparisons

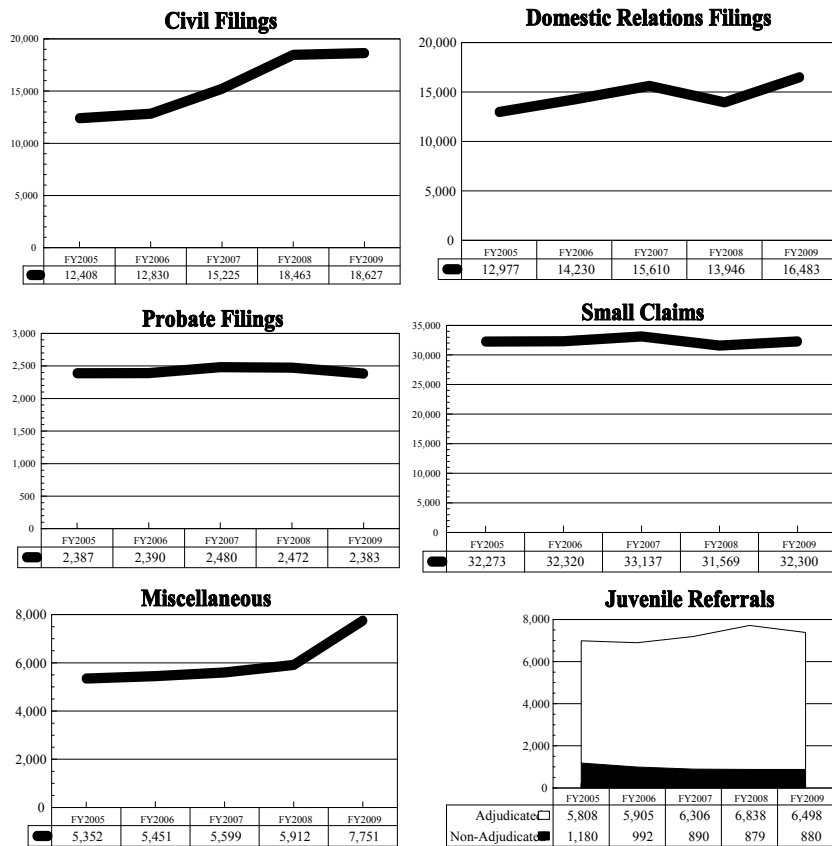
