

MARRIAGE

The following list of counties have Clerk Magistrates who can perform marriages at the courthouse during working hours based upon availability of staff and workload. It is highly recommended to call ahead and schedule a date/time for the ceremony or you may be turned away if you arrive without an appointment. When you appear at the courthouse for your wedding, you must bring along the following items:

1. The marriage certificate you received from the Register of Deeds office;
2. \$20.00 for the fee to be paid to the Clerk of Courts office; and
3. Two witnesses (with ID's).

If a county does not appear on this list, they do not perform marriages at the courthouse.
