<ul> <li>Complete the Motion for Expungement UJS-391A by:</li> <li>Fill in the caption by entering the name of the county you are filing in and listing your name on the line provided as the Petitioner. (The county you file in will be the same county where the arrest record or case is filed in.)</li> <li>The case number will be provided to you by the Clerk of Court at the time of filing.</li> <li>Fill in the remainder of UJS-391A on the lines provided and select the appropriate basis for the Motion.</li> <li>Sign, date, and file with the Clerk of Court along with the Case Filing Statement UJS-232 and pay the \$72 filing fee.</li> </ul>
Complete only the caption of the Admission of Service UJS-391B. The remainder of the form will need to be completed by the States Attorney and/or their office who handled your criminal case.
Mail a copy of the Motion for Expungement UJS-391A, the partially completed Admission of Service UJS-391B, and a self-addressed stamped envelope to the States Attorney and/or their office who handled your criminal case.  □ The States Attorney will need to sign the Admission of Service UJS-391B as proof of service that they received your Motion for Expungement.
Complete the Statement of Mailing UJS-391C once you have mailed a copy of your Motion for Expungement UJS-391A and Admission of Service UJS-391B to the States Attorney.
File the Statement of Mailing UJS-391C with the Clerk of Court.
File the Admission of Service UJS-391B with the Clerk of Court once you receive it back from the States Attorney.
