WHETHER DEFENDANT'S PAROLE AGENT NEEDED
REASONABLE SUSPICION TO REQUEST THAT DEFENDANT
SUBMIT TO A UA AND IF SO WHETHER HE HAD
REASONABLE SUSPICION?

The trial court granted Defendant's Motion to Suppress concluding that Defendant's parole officer must have reasonable suspicion to request Defendant to submit to a UA and that there was no reasonable suspicion present in this situation.
