4.

WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN FAILING TO GRANT SWALVE'S MOTION TO SUPPRESS CERTAIN EVIDENCE SEIZED BY VIRTUE OF AN ILLEGAL SEARCH AND SEIZURE.

The trial Court denied Swalve's Motion to Suppress.

5.

WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN ALLOWING AN UNDISCLOSED WITNESS TO TESTIFY DURING THE STATE'S CASE IN CHIEF.
