- I. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN PERMITTING STATEMENTS TO BE ADMITTED UNDER SDCL 19-16-38, AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE HEARSAY RULE?
- II. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN FINDING R.B. WAS COMPETENT TO TESTIFY?
- III. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN DENYING APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR MISTRIAL?
- IV. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN DENYING APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR A NEW TRIAL BASED ON NEW EVIDENCE?
- V. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN NOT DISMISSING THE PART II HABITUAL OFFENDER INFORMATION?
- VI. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT ERRED IN PREVENTING APPELLANT FROM OFFERING TESTIMONY RELATING TO VARIOUS MATTERS?
- VII. WHETHER THE SENTENCE IMPOSED IS CONSTITUTES CRUEL AND UNUSUAL PUNISHMENT?
