STATEMENT OF LEGAL ISSUES

I. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT'S DIVISION AND DISTRIBUTION OF MARITAL ASSETS CONSTITUTES AN ABUSE OF DISCRETION IN THAT IT PRODUCED UNFAIR AND INEQUITABLE RESULTS.

The trial court allocated to Joe the present value lump sum of his military retirement, did not divide the appreciation of certain real estate, declined to award any income producing property to Joe, provided Jodie with a credit for certain post-separation debt, and awarded Jodie the marital residence.
