A hearing was held on January 11, 2017, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of SDCL 16-19-36 and the Court having considered the proposed amendment and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is


ORDERED that SDCL 16-19-36 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

SDCL 16-19-36. Attorney's conviction of crime to be reported to Disciplinary Board. Any attorney and the clerk of any court in this state in which an attorney is convicted of a crime, except those misdemeanor traffic offenses or traffic ordinance violations not involving the use of alcohol or drugs, shall within ten days of said conviction transmit a certificate thereof to the Disciplinary Board. If such certificate is for conviction of a serious crime as defined in § 16-19-37, the board shall promptly transmit the same to the Supreme Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective immediately.


