The Court being authorized to establish the number of full-time, law-trained magistrate positions in the State of South Dakota, and the Court having determined that the number of said positions should be increased in the Second and Third Judicial Circuits, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that SDCL 16-12A-3.1 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

16-12A-3.1. Number of full-time, law-trained magistrates. The number of full-time, law-trained magistrates in the judicial circuits established by § 16-5-1.2 is fixed as follows:

- (1) First Circuit: One full-time, law-trained
 magistrate;
- (2) Second Circuit: Three full-time, law-trained magistrates;
- (3) Third Circuit: One full-time, law-trained magistrate;
- (4) Fifth Circuit: One full-time, law-trained magistrates;
- (5) Seventh Circuit: Two full-time, law-trained magistrates; and
- (6) Eighth Circuit: One full-time, law-trained magistrate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective July 1, 1994.
