STATEMENT OF LEGAL ISSUES

The Trial Court committed errors and made rulings which raise the following appellate issues.

I. WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT PROPERLY GRANTED SUMMARY JUDGMENT TO SHERIFF JUNG ON EITHER QUALIFIED IMMUNITY OR ON THE GOVERNMENT NOTICE STATUTE.

The Trial Court granted Summary Judgment without a written decision.

WHETHER THE TRIAL COURT PROPERLY GRANTED SUMMARY JUDGMENT TO EQUITABLE BASED UPON THE DOCTRINE OF SUPERSEDING CAUSE.

The Trial Court granted Summary Judgment without a written decision.

STATEMENT OF THE LEGAL ISSUE

WHETHER THE SHERIFF'S VIOLATION OF HIS LEGAL DUTY TO CANCEL THE SALE IN ACCORDANCE WITH EQUITABLE'S INSTRUCTIONS WAS A SUPERSEDING CAUSE OF ANY DAMAGES CLAIMED BY THE PLAINTIFFS.

The lower court granted Equitable's motion for summary judgment, holding that the sheriff's violation of his legal duty was a superseding cause in accordance with the Restatement (Second) of Torts, § 452(2) and *Braun v. New Hope Township*.
