ORDERED that the adoption of a new rule relating to the formatting of pleadings in the courts be and it is hereby adopted to read in its entirety as follows:

The formatting of pleadings in the courts.

Section 1. All pleadings, motions, orders and other papers filed with the court, with the exception of exhibits, shall be typewritten or hand printed in a clear and legible manner, no smaller than 12 point type; on one side only of white, unglazed, opaque paper of good texture, eight and one-half inches wide and eleven inches long; and consecutively numbered at the bottom center of each page.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the rule shall become effective immediately.
