STATEMENT OF LEGAL ISSUES

- 1. Whether the Appellant's Fourth Amendment right (as well as the South Dakota counterpart thereto) to be free from unreasonable searches and seizures was violated when a state trooper ordered that Appellant's blood be seized for testing and analysis, without consent, without reading the implied consent, and without detention or custody.
- 2. Whether the circuit court erred in allowing the state to elicit answers from Trooper Fox identifying which statements of defendant he believed were untruthful when defendant did not testify.
 - 3. Whether the trial court erred in disallowing the use of exculpatory hearsay.
- 4. Whether the trial court's refusal to give theory of defense instructions on the duty to preserve evidence and inferences drawn from spoliation of evidence constitutes reversible error, a denial of fair trial, and a deprivation of due process under the State and Federal Constitution.
