ORDERED that SDCL 16-18-2.7 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

SDCL 16-18-2.7. Oral argument by legal intern before Supreme Court. A legal intern may participate in oral argument before the Supreme Court but only in the presence of a supervising lawyer who shall certify to the court in his or her introduction of the legal intern to the court that the client has approved the participation by the legal intern.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the rule shall become effective July 1, 2011.
