LEGAL ISSUES INVOLVED

This proceeding concerns the extent of the final discipline to be imposed on William J. Janklow (Respondent) following suspension of Respondent's license to practice law on December 15, 2003 pursuant to S.D.C.L. § 16-19-37 following Respondent's conviction of second degree manslaughter, a felony, by a Moody County, South Dakota, jury. The jury also convicted Respondent of failure to stop at a stop sign, speeding and reckless driving.

LEGAL ISSUES INVOLVED

Respondent concurs in the Board's statement of the legal issues involved in this matter. However, while the Board's statement refers to a conviction of second degree manslaughter, respondent actually received a suspended imposition of sentence pursuant to SDCL 23A-27-13:
