REVIEW OF CONDITIONAL ADMIDSION /

A hearing was held on February 19, 2014, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the adoption of a new rule to be designated at SDCL 16-16-17.5 and the Court having considered the proposed adoption and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that adoption of a new rule to be designated at SDCL 16-16-17.5 relating to review of conditional admission be and it is hereby adopted to read in its entirety as follows:

SDCL 16-16-17.5. Review of conditional admission. The Board of Bar Examiners shall review each conditional admission no later than the date specified in the Supreme Court's order granting conditional admission. The Board shall recommend to the Supreme Court that:

- (1) The conditional admission be terminated, resulting in loss of license; or
- (2) That the conditional admission be modified and/or extended; or
- (3) That full admission be granted.

The Supreme Court may accept or reject the recommendation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective July 1, 2014.
