relating thereto, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that the Amendment to the Appendix to Chapter

16-16 Regulations of the Board of Bar Examiners is amended to read
in its entirety as follows:

## 7.1. Law Student Registration.

Applicants to law school and first-or second-year law students who intend to take the South Dakota <u>bBar</u> eExamination following graduation may register with the Board of Bar Examiners on forms prescribed by the Board through the Bar Portal. The registration must be accompanied by the \$100 South Dakota registration fee as well as the fee required by the National Conference of Bar Examiners' law student registrant program for an initial character report. Registration under the rule is not deemed an application for permission to take the bar examination.

The Board of Bar Examiners shall review the registration and character report to identify character and fitness issues that may hinder or preclude later admission.

The Board will report its findings to the registrant. The Board's findings are both preliminary and non-binding in nature. Additionally, the findings will not constitute permission to take the bar examination or a waiver of the consideration of facts or conduct that are either later discovered or occur after the Board's review under this rule.
