A hearing was held on August 28, 2008, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of SDCL 16-13-31.1, and the Court having considered the proposed amendment and oral presentation relating thereto and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that SDCL 16-13-31.1 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Public inspection. All records, lists, papers, tickets, and other materials used in all stages of the jury selection process shall be preserved in the custody of the clerk of courts for four years or for such longer period as may be required by the court and shall, upon court order, be available for inspection for the purpose of determining the validity of the selection of any jury.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the rule shall become effective November 1, 2008.
