A hearing was held on February 15, 2012, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the adoption of a new rule to be designated at SDCL 16-16-17.4 and the Court having considered the proposed adoption and the oral presentation relating thereto and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that SDCL 16-16-17.4 be and it is hereby adopted to read in its entirety as follows:

SDCL 16-16-17.4. Report of recommendation to Supreme Court. In the event that a majority of the members of the Board of Bar Examiners votes to recommend the conditional admission of an applicant, the Board shall report to the Supreme Court the matters of concern, the nature, substance, and duration of the course of treatment or remediation in which the applicant is engaged, complete and detailed information regarding the applicant's progress in connection therewith including any lapses or failures, the Board's recommendation regarding the terms and conditions of admission, any additional facts relevant to the recommendation, and confirmation of the applicant's consent to admission on a conditional basis.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the rule shall become effective July 1, 2012.
