IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 1 OF THE REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF BAR EXAMINERS (APPENDIX TO SDCL 16-16)

RULE 98-10

A hearing having been held on February 20, 1998, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of Regulation 1 of the Regulations of the Board of Bar Examiners (Appendix to SDCL 16-16), and the Court having considered the proposed amendment, the correspondence and oral presentations relating thereto, if any, and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is ORDERED that said regulation (Appendix to SDCL 16-16) be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Each applicant for admission to practice law must file with the secretary of the Board of Bar Examiners a written application, together with five complete machine or photo copies thereof, in the form prescribed by the Board of Bar Examiners. Such application and copies thereof shall be filed by November 15 for the February examination and April 15 for the July examination and shall be accompanied by the fee prescribed in the applicable rules of court and a recent photograph of the applicant. The Board of Bar Examiners in its discretion may waive the filing deadline for good cause shown and supported by affidavit and late fee, provided, however, that no application will be considered unless filed by December 15 for the February examination and May 15 for the July examination.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED this this rule shall become effective July 1, 1998.
