IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT OF RULE II OF THE SOUTH DAKOTA SUPREME COURT DISCIPLINARY RULES (APPENDIX TO SDCL 16-19)

RULE 98-23

A hearing having been held on February 20, 1998, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of Rule II of the South Dakota Supreme Court Disciplinary Rules (Appendix to SDCL 16-19), and the Court having considered the proposed amendment, the correspondence and oral presentations relating thereto, if any, and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that said rule (Appendix to SDCL 16-19) be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

RULE II.

Upon receipt of a written complaint by the Secretary-Treasurer from whatever source that he deems not frivolous, the Secretary-Treasurer shall acknowledge receipt of the complaint and notify the complainant of the name and address of the Disciplinary Board member to whom this complaint is assigned.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective July 1, 1998.
