A hearing having been held on February 25, 1999, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of SDCL 15-26A-68, and the Court having considered the proposed amendment, the correspondence and oral presentations relating thereto, if any, and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that the SDCL 15-26A-68 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

15-26A-68. Reproduction methods used for briefs. Text must be reproduced with a clarity that equals or exceeds the output of a laser printer. The output of a dot-matrix printer or fax machine is not acceptable in either a brief or an appendix.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective July 1, 1999.


