ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR ALTERNATIVE WRIT OF MANDAMUS and ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR ALTERNATIVE WRIT OF PROHIBITION

Applicants having filed an application for permission to commence an original mandamus and/or prohibition proceeding and a verified application for alternative writ of mandamus and/or alternative writ of prohibition in the above-entitled matter on October 13, 2021, requesting that this Court: 1) enter a writ of mandamus compelling South Dakota Speaker of the House of Representatives, Spencer Gosch, to disclose the names of the members of the House of Representatives who signed the "Petition For Special Session On Impeachment"; and/or 2) enter a writ of prohibition barring Speaker Gosch from convening the aforementioned special session unless and until the names of the petitioners are publicly disclosed; and

The Court having considered the applications and the "Proclamation Convening the Legislature in Special Session on November

ORDERED that the application for the commencement of an original mandamus proceeding and the issuance of an alternative writ of mandamus is denied pursuant to SDCL 21-29-2 because Applicants have a plain, speedy, and adequate remedy, in the ordinary course of law to seek the public disclosure of the names of the members of the House of Representatives who signed the petition. It is further

ORDERED that the application for the commencement of an original prohibition proceeding and the issuance of an alternative writ of prohibition is denied pursuant to SDCL 21-30-1 because the non-disclosure of the names of the members of the House of Representatives who signed the petition does not in and of itself implicate the question of whether Speaker Gosch convened the special session "in excess of the powers of authority conferred by law upon" him under Article III, § 31 of the South Dakota Constitution.
