Pursuant to a hearing held on February 14, 1991, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of Regulation 2 of the Regulations of the Board of Bar Examiners, the Court having considered the proposed amendment, the correspondence and oral presentations relating thereto, if any, and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that the amendment of Regulation 2 of the Regulations of the Board of Bar Examiners be and it hereby is approved in accordance with SDCL 16-16-5, said Regulation to read in its entirety as follows:

2. Application Forms and Payment of Fees. All fees shall be paid by money order or certified check. The application form shall require each applicant to waive confidentiality and privacy rights in order to allow the Board of Bar Examiners to inquire into the applicant's moral character through examination of state, federal, police, court and security records.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective July 1, 1991.
