- \$7.50: Court Appointed Attorney and Public Defender Fund
- \$5.00: Victim's Compensation Fund
- \$2.50: 911 Telecommunicator Training Fund
- \$2.00: Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Fund
- \$1.00: Abused and Neglected Child Defense Fund
