A hearing having been held on February 10, 2003, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment of State Bar By-Law Section 27, and the Court having considered the proposed amendment, the correspondence and oral presentations relating thereto, if any, and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that State Bar By-Law Section 27 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS.

Section 27. No resolution of motion, complimentary to any officer or member for any service performed, paper read, or address delivered, shall be made to or considered by the State Bar.

Other resolutions shall be submitted in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer by May 1st of each year, which the Secretary-Treasurer shall publish in the State Bar Annual Meeting Program. In addition, the proposed resolution shall be conspicuously posted at the annual meeting with sufficient copies made available to membership in attendance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective July 1, 2003.
