IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT TO SDCL 16-6-1.

RULE 19-14

A hearing was held on April 30, 2019, at Pierre, South Dakota, relating to the amendment to SDCL 16-6-1, and the Court having considered the proposed amendment and being fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that SDCL 16-6-1 be and it is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

SDCL 16-6-1. Number of judges in judicial circuits. The number of circuit judges of each of the judicial circuits established by \S 16-5-1.2 is as follows:

- (1) First Circuit: Six circuit judges;
- (2) Second Circuit: Eleven Twelve circuit judges;
- (3) Third Circuit: Six circuit judges;
- (4) Fourth Circuit: Four circuit judges;
- (5) Fifth Circuit: Four circuit judges;
- (6) Sixth Circuit: Four circuit judges;
- (7) Seventh Circuit: Eight circuit judges.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become effective immediately.
