STANDING ORDER


Pursuant to the March 13, 2020, South Dakota Supreme Court Order Declaring Judicial Emergency due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, as well as applicable provisions of SDCL 16-2-21, the Honorable Robin Houwman, Presiding Judge for the Second Judicial Circuit, with the approval of Chief Justice David Gilbertson, does hereby

ORDER that the court may permit attorney-entered pleas for juveniles where the plea agreement does not require intensive probation, detention time, or commitments to the Department of Corrections. Juveniles must meet with their attorney, state their understanding of the plea agreement, verify the attorney has advised the juvenile of their rights, agree with the statement of facts that support their admissions, and confirm that they have received instruction on when and where they will be meeting with court services. Such findings shall be made on the record by the judge presiding over the case.

THIS ORDER shall be in effect until modified or terminated by the presiding judge.

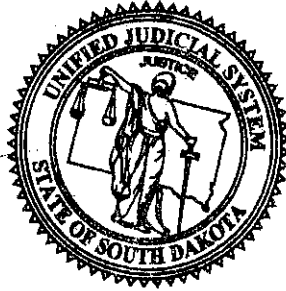
