COVID-19 Response



The South Dakota Unified Judicial System is committed to providing services to the public in a manner that allows access to the court system but also recognizes the importance of the well-being of those that do business with the courts including the public, litigants, witnesses, jurors, attorneys and court staff.

On March 13, 2020 the South Dakota Supreme Court declared a judicial emergency from the COVID 19 Disease in the <u>attached order</u>. That order granted the Presiding Judges of each of South Dakota's seven judicial circuits the authority to enter orders to respond to the public health emergency in their respective jurisdictions.
