ORDER REGARDING COURT
PROCEEDINGS DURING THE
STURGIS MOTORCYCLE RALLY

Following the declaration of a Judicial Emergency by the South Dakota Supreme Court, it is hereby

ORDERED the Fourth Judicial Circuit Court will implement the following steps to help reduce the spread of Covid-19 during the annual gathering known as the STURGIS MOTORCYCLE RALLY:

All members of the public entering the judicial buildings of either the Meade County Courthouse or the Lawrence County Courthouse shall wear protective facial coverings such as a mask, scarf, bandana or other cloth which covers the nose and mouth, during the time that such individuals are present in the Courthouse.

Only persons directly involved in court proceedings as a party, witness, or victim are allowed in the judicial building to minimize the number of people gathering and potentially spreading COVID-19. Each court session shall be available in audio form to the public by a telephonic conference system.

This Order will be in effect August 7, 2020 through August 16, 2020


