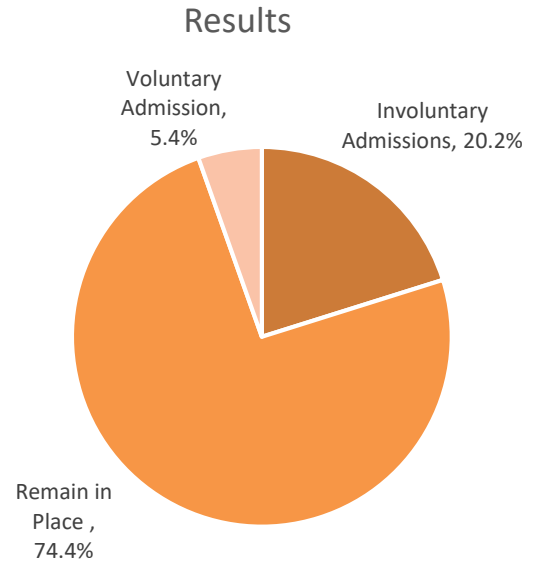
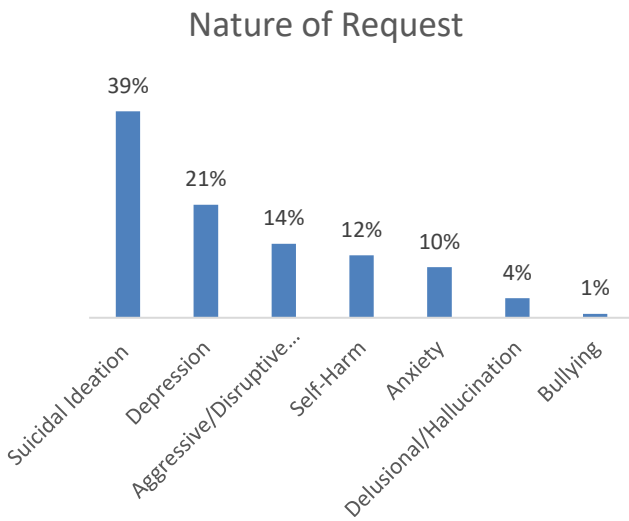

Legislative Update

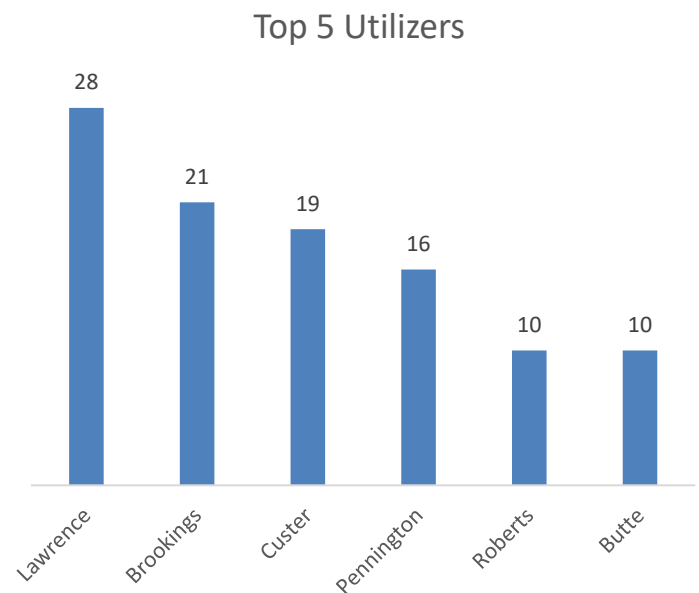
This legislative session, the Unified Judicial System requested an increase of \$285,000 in general funds to extend the Virtual Crisis Care Pilot through FY 2022. The UJS also requested an increase of \$75,000 in general funds to allow six additional counties to join the pilot.
