A hearing was held on April 30, 2019, at Pierre,
South Dakota, relating to the amendment to SDCL 16-12B-1.1, and
the Court having considered the proposed amendment and being
fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED that SDCL 16-12B-1.1 be and it is hereby
amended to read in its entirety as follows:

SDCL 16-12B-1.1. Number of magistrate judges. The
number of magistrate judges in the judicial circuits established
by § 16-5-1.2 is fixed as follows:

- (1) First Circuit: Two full-time magistrate judges;
- (2) Second Circuit: Four full-time magistrate judges;
- (3) Third Circuit: Two full-time magistrate judges;
- (4) Fourth Circuit: Two full-time magistrate judges;
~~One full-time and one part-time magistrate judge~~
- (5) Fifth Circuit: One full-time magistrate judge;
- (6) Sixth Circuit: One full-time magistrate judge; and
- (7) Seventh Circuit: Four full-time magistrate judges.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall become
effective immediately.
